

10-year history of electric rates

Maine law requires investor-owned transmission and distribution utilities to provide customers with a bill insert once a year that displays a 10-year history of transmission, distribution and standard offer service rates.

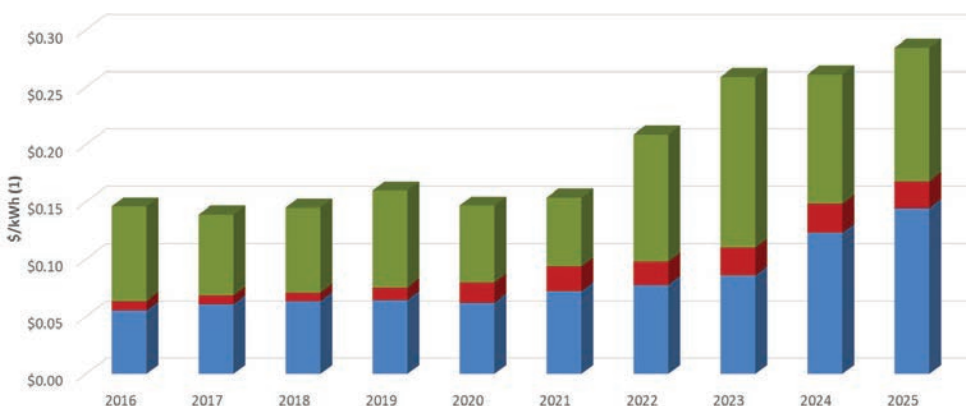
Transmission and distribution rates reflect the cost to bring electricity from where it is made to your home.

(1) \$/kWh are annual revenue per kWh amounts inclusive of all fixed, demand and per-kWh charges.

(2) "Other" includes costs associated with state policy programs, including funding for Efficiency Maine, low-income programs, net energy billing, and other renewable energy programs.

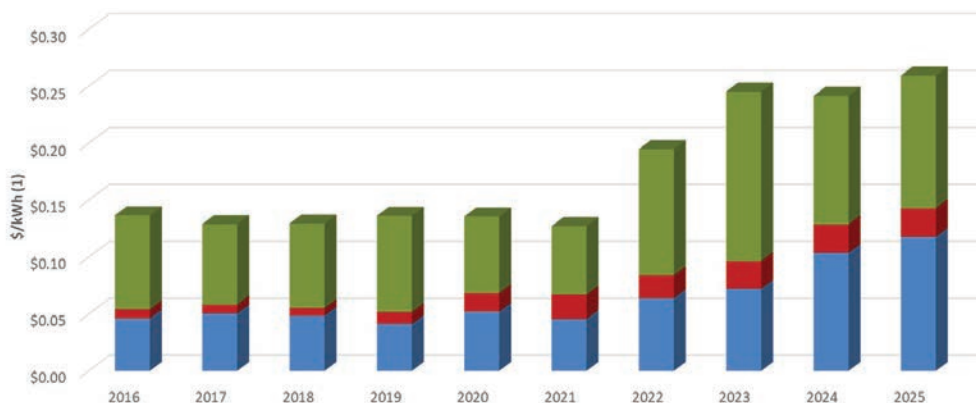
(3) Standard Offer service is the default rate for electricity supply. The Maine Public Utilities Commission administers competitive bidding for Standard Offer service. Versant Power does not generate or sell electricity, but we bill on behalf of those who do.

Rate Code A: Residential Service



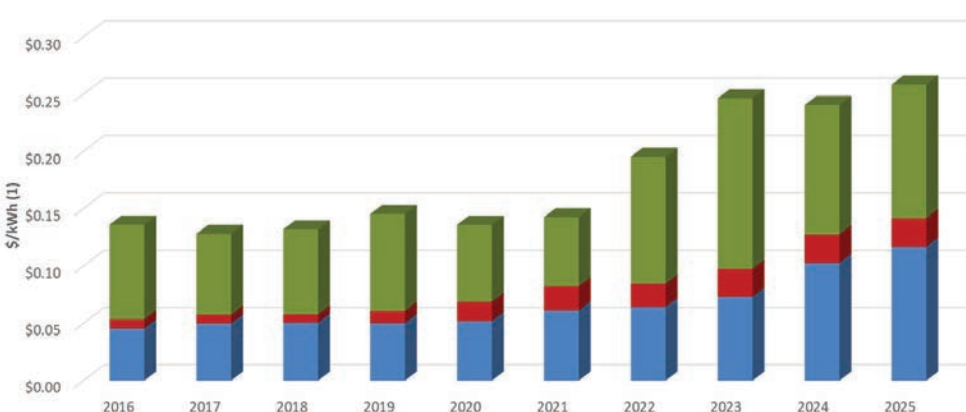

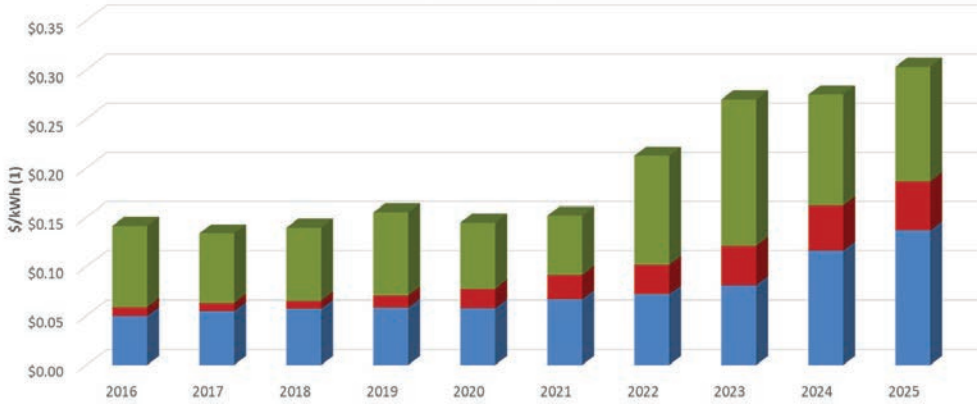
Rate Code AHN: Home Heating Eco - New Installations

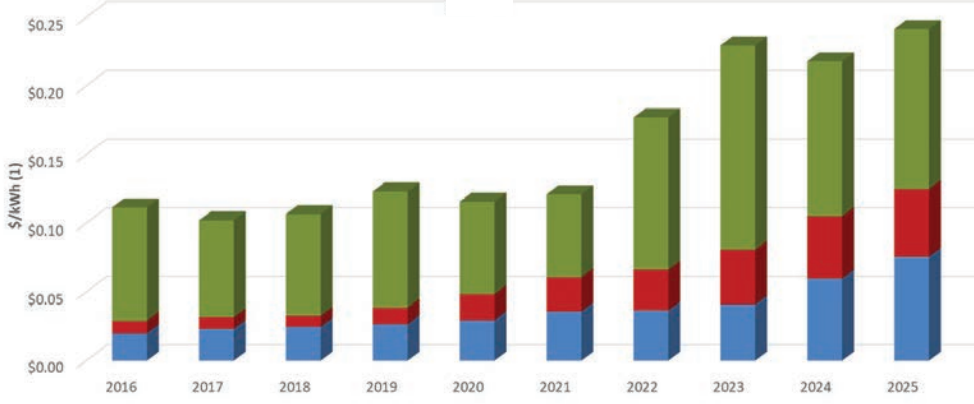


Rate Code C: Business Eco



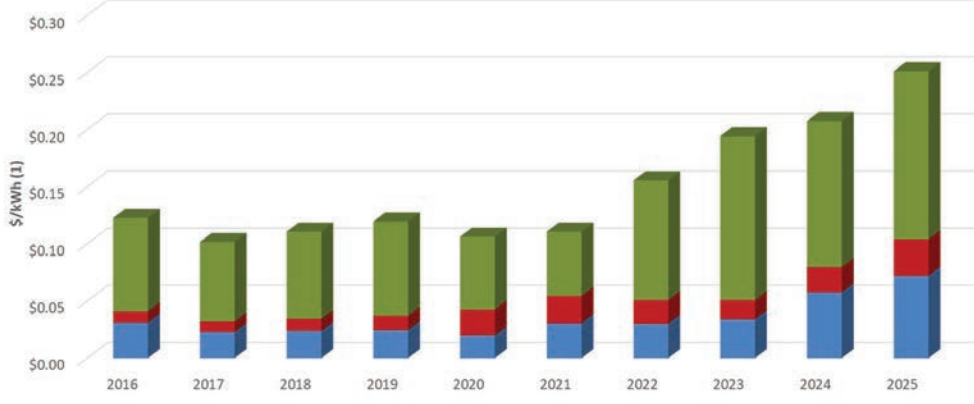

Rate Code D2: Municipal Water Pumping



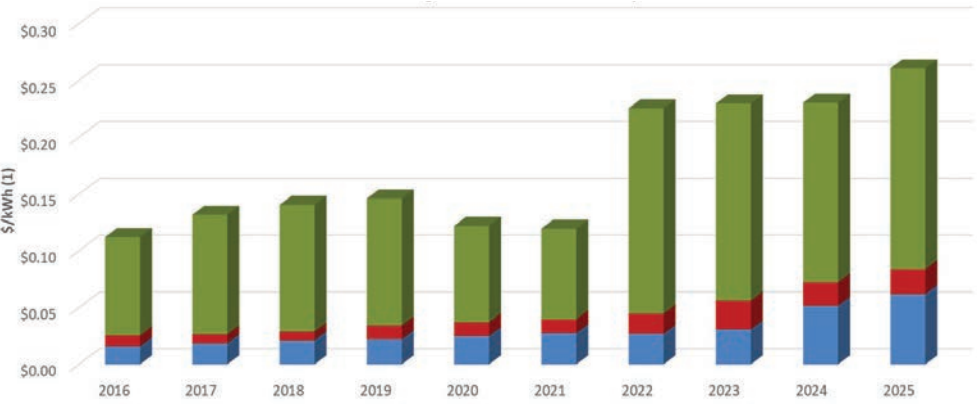

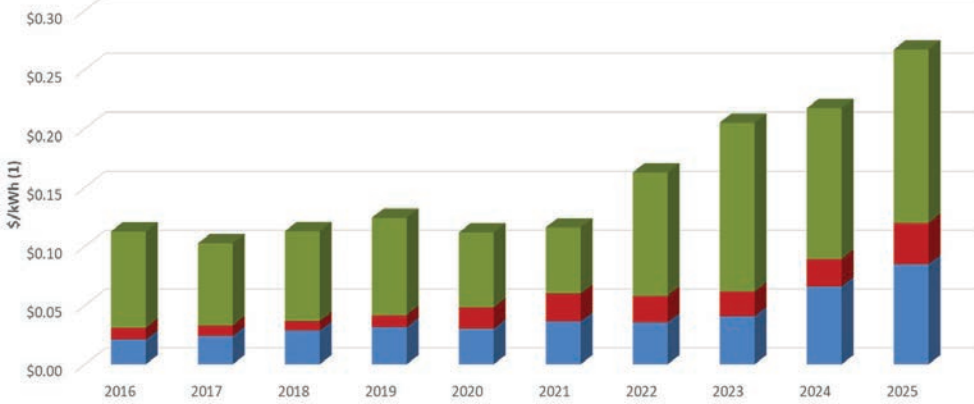

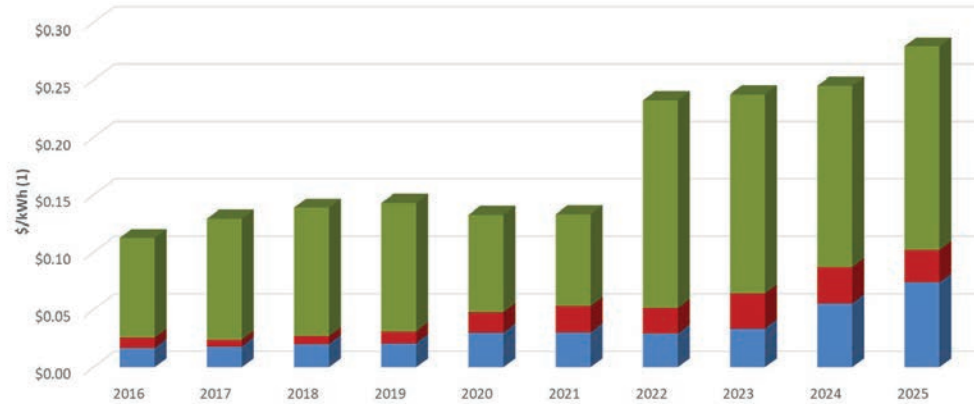

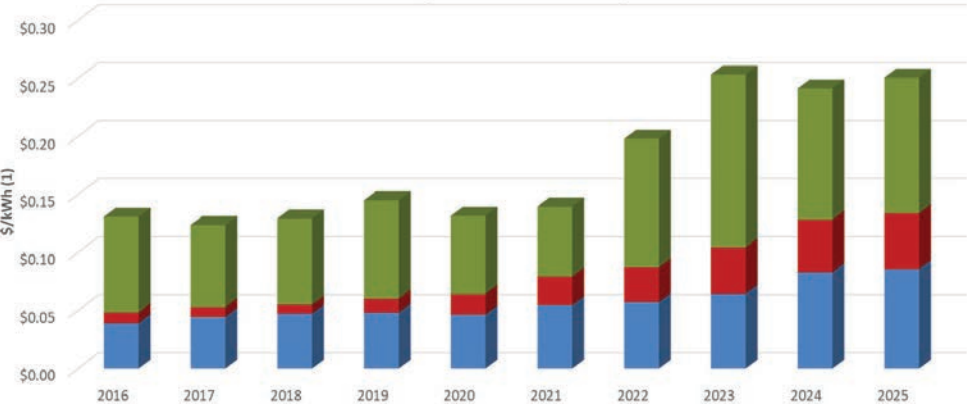

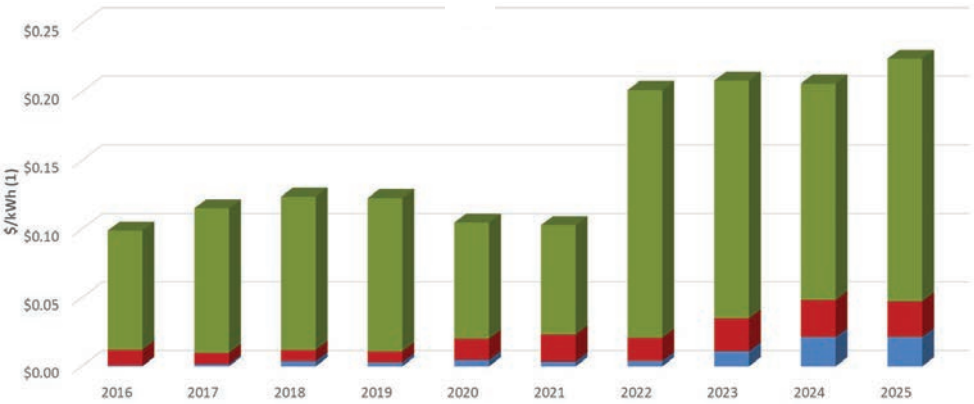

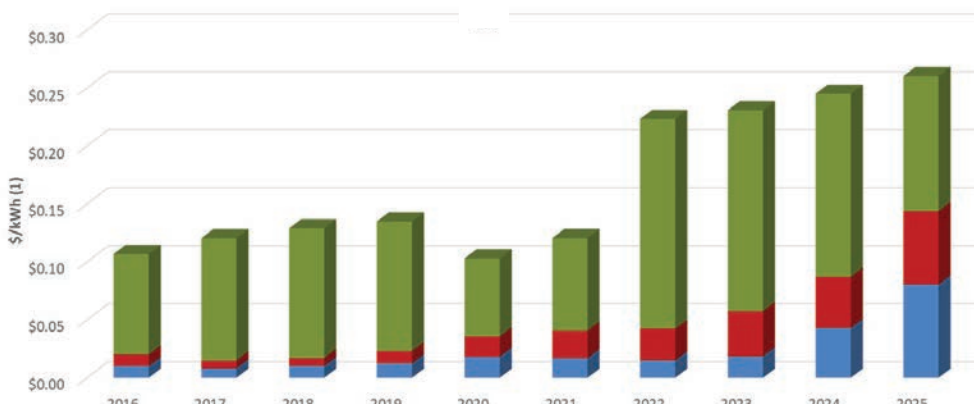

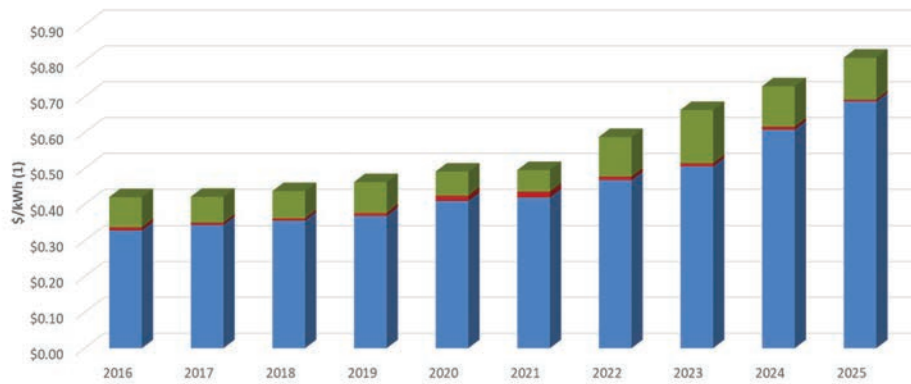

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Rate Code SL: Street Lighting

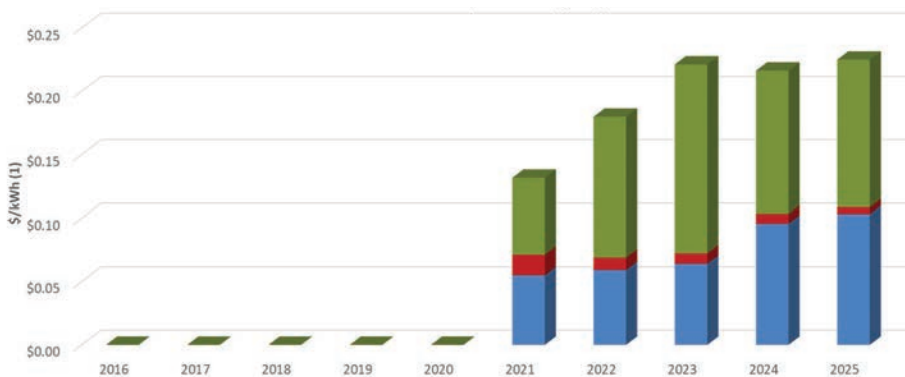

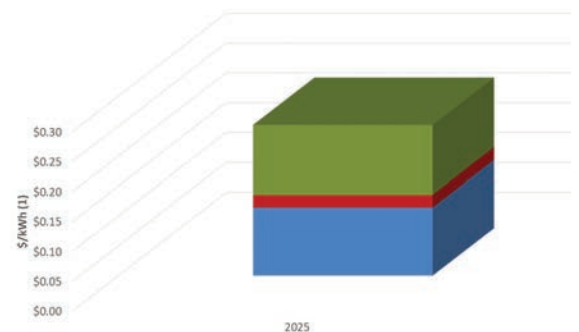
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Rate Code SL2: Municipal Street Lighting

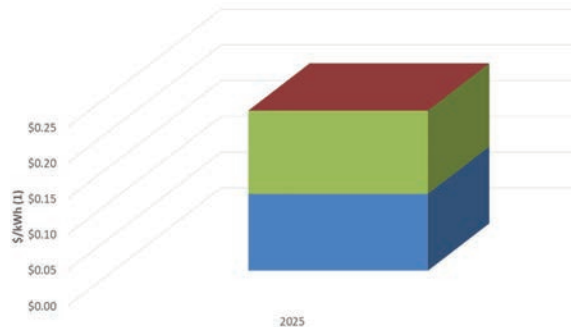

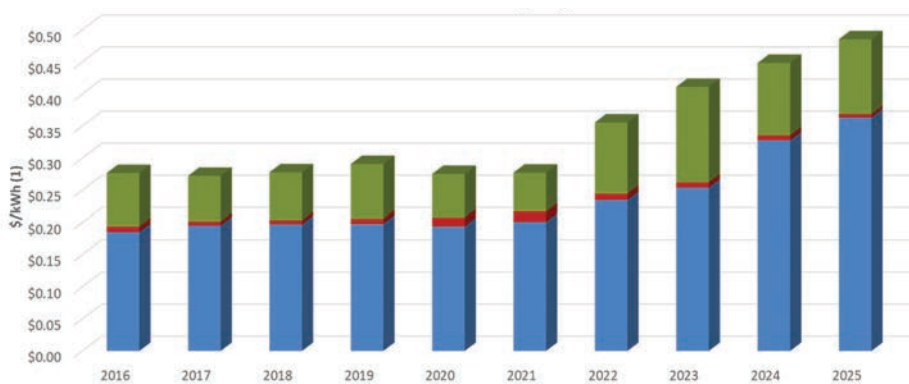
Rate Code A-4M: Home Eco Rate - TOU
