

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

Available:

This rate is available to any year-round customer for residential service as defined in the Company's Terms and Conditions.

Character of Service:

Service will be single phase, alternating current, 60 hertz, at the standard available voltage described in the Company's Standard Requirements.

- (1) Service hereunder is subject to the Company's Terms and Conditions.
- (2) If the Company permits more than one residential unit to be served through one meter, the minimum bill and block size shall be multiplied by the number of separate residential units so served.
- (3) A military veterans' organization qualified under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, 26 United States Code, Section 501(c)(19), as amended, may request that electric delivery service to its facility be billed under the residential rates described in this schedule. A trust or foundation for a post or organization of past or present members of the Armed Forces of the United States is not eligible for service under this schedule. To be eligible for service under this schedule, the qualifying military veterans' organization must be billed directly for electric delivery service provided by the company.

This provision shall expire effective September 1, 2025. Upon expiration, the Company will place the customer on the non-residential rate that matches the customer's usage characteristics for the previous 12 months.

Transmission Service:

The above rate includes all charges for transmission under the Company's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT").

HOME ECO RATE
Time-Of-Use

Character of Service:

Service under this rate is available for lighting and other domestic purposes in individual apartments. It is not applicable where the use of electricity is for commercial purposes. This rate is available for residential customers, on a whole house basis for the purposes of general residential electric usage including Electric Vehicle and Electric Battery Storage end-uses. Customers taking service under this rate schedule are responsible for paying both Distribution Service and Stranded Cost.

For the purpose of applying off-peak energy charges in any of the Company's time of use rates, holidays shall include New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Patriot's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas as the same are actually observed in any year.
