Emera Maine - Notice of Agreement in Principle for Discounted Transmission Charges

Point of Receipt: Emera Maine, Maine Public District Transmission System

Point of Delivery: New Brunswick

Time Period: October 1, 2018 – December 31, 2019 – \$0/MW-Month for Schedule 7 and/or Schedule 8; January 1, 2020 – December 31, 2020, \$1,132 per MW-Month for Schedule 7 and/or Schedule 8.

Emera Maine has reached an agreement in principle with ReEnergy to a discounted rate of \$0 for Schedule 7 and/or 8 charges under the Emera Maine Open Access Transmission Tariff for Maine Public District (MPD OATT) with a point of delivery at the New Brunswick border for the period October 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019. Emera Maine will offer Schedule 7 and/or 8 charges for the calendar year 2020 at the rate of \$1,132 per MW-Month.

Emera Maine intends to file with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), on or about July 31, 2018, a transmission service agreement (TSA) between itself and ReEnergy setting forth this discounted rate and providing, among other things, that, if Emera Maine's filing is not accepted by October 1, 2018 without condition, suspension or refund obligation, Emera Maine will continue to charge the current tariff rate unless and until a discounted rate is approved by FERC in a final decision no longer subject to appeal.

In accordance with FERC policy (*see, e.g.*, Order No. 888-A, FERC Stats. & Regs. ¶ 31,048, at 30,275), Emera Maine offers this same discounted rate for Schedule 7 and 8 service under the MPD OATT on all unconstrained paths with a point of delivery at the New Brunswick border for the period October 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020, subject to the execution of a TSA and its acceptance by FERC without condition, suspension or refund obligation.
