RE: Versant Power proposes waiver of charges between NMISA and ISO New England

Versant Power is working jointly with the Northern Maine Independent System Administrator (NMISA) to request and implement a reciprocal arrangement to waive certain tolls, known as “out charges,” between NMISA and ISO New England for energy that sources or sinks in either region. This change is sought to increase the efficient exchange of energy between the two regions.

This proposed tariff change will require approval by various New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) stakeholder committees associated with ISO-New England, as well as the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC).
